➤ **Where will the in-service be held?**

➤ **How do I register for the in-service?**

Registration will begin at 9:15 a.m. Please make sure to arrive early enough to register as the first meeting will begin at 10:00 a.m. The registration area will be located inside the main lobby across from the main auditorium. *PLEASE REFER TO THE DRAFT PROGRAM SCHEDULE.*

➤ **How can I get to the in-service?**

Please work through your principal for all travel arrangements. Your administrator will have details on car-pooling as a school. The CCC Office of Education will reimburse each school .39 cents per mile for a single car-pooled vehicle.

➤ **What is the theme for the in-service?**

The theme for the in-service and school year is 1 Thessalonians 5:11 (NIV) “Therefore encourage one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing.”

➤ **What time is the first meeting?**

The first meeting will begin at 10:00 a.m., and it will be inside the main auditorium.

➤ **Will I have to make my own meal arrangements?**

No. Sweet Tomatoes will be catering lunch for the event.

➤ **Can I get certification Professional Activity Credit (PAC) for attending the Summit?**

Six hours of Professional Activity Credit is available to all attendees.
